Summary Report



Holidays, for most of us, offer an escape to somewhere new, somewhere different. The chance to get away from the day to day, have fun and make memories. For many families across greater Glasgow, however, that opportunity is out of reach. Around one-third of children living in Glasgow are living in poverty. Many of those children and young people have never or rarely had the chance of a break. A break that can help improve mental health, broaden experiences and promote wellbeing for the whole family. It can be such a lifeline for parents and carers and their children.

For nearly 70 years Glasgow Children's Holiday Scheme has provided holidays to thousands of disadvantaged children and their families. The chance to break the routine, enjoy some relaxation, have fun and build positive memories.

In 2023, we enjoyed another fabulous year providing holidays and breaks from March to November. Families enjoyed a holiday at our 5 caravans at Wemyss Bay Holiday Park with additional caravan capacity purchased at the peak school holiday periods. Young people enjoyed a break at our caravans with their youth groups. Families enjoyed days out they otherwise would not have been able to manage and groups enjoyed day trips. The feedback we received was hugely positive with short and long term benefits.

We thank funders, supporters and volunteers for helping us to make such a difference to people's lives.

In 2023, we enabled:

218 families, 375 adults and 448 children and young people to enjoy a caravan holiday.

This included:

34 families affected by alcohol or drug/substance misuse



44 families affected by bereavement
113 adults/ children with mental health issues

39 families affected by domestic violence
74 children on the autism spectrum

36 adults with a physical/ learning disability

4 adults with sensory impairment

39 families who were/are victims of abuse/harassment

35 children with school behavioural issues

56 children with additional educational needs

30 children with a physical disability

48 children with a learning disability

31 children with sensory impairment

43 children with multiple care needs
79 pre-5 children
27 young carers
37 kinship carers
101 single parent carers, of which **91** were **female**
8 asylum seeker/refugee families
21 families from an ethnic minority group



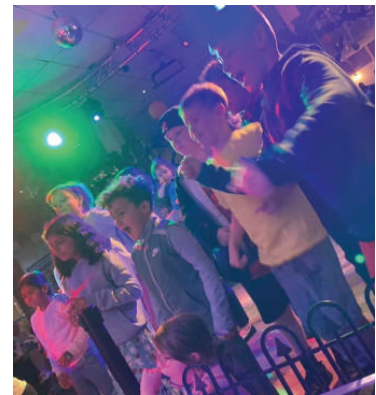
We supported youth groups to have **5** short breaks away with over **40 young people** benefitting and facilitated a weekend retreat for **women** and **children** impacted by domestic abuse.

We helped individual groups to organise over a **dozen** separate day trips with over **150 children** and **young people** participating. Trips included Blair Drummond, Heads of Ayr and the David Livingstone Centre.

85 families and **232 children** and **young people** supported through our **annual Christmas Gift Scheme**.



Over **40 families** and **85 children** and **young people** had a day out including trips to the seaside, farm park and sports events as well as bowling, soft play and enjoying a meal out.
