HOUSE KEEPING

- Please do not bring any pets to the holiday park as some children are allergic to animal hair.
- Strictly no smoking or vaping inside the caravans.
- After you have finished your stay, please turn off all the lights and the heating.
- Please strip the beds upon leaving the caravans at the end of your stay. We would appreciate it if you could leave the caravans clean and tidy. Please leave bedding in the caravan once beds are stripped.
- Any issues upon arrival, or with the caravan during your stay, please contact reception.
- Please bring your own towels and tea towels.
- All clean bedding is provided at the start of your stay.
- There is a launderette on site, laundry detergent included.
- There are two large gas cannisters located at the back of each caravan



GETTING TO THE HOLIDAY PARK

- The train from Glasgow Central to Wemyss Bay station runs hourly. Kids travel on Scotrail for £1 each, adult ticket £8.40.
- The 901 and 906 bus from Glasgow Buchanan Street Bus Station runs regularly.
 - GoZone adult day ticket is £5.70, kids GoZone day ticket is £2.10 or free with a YoungScot Card. GoZone 3 tickets cover the whole Inverclyde network, including Wemyss Bay–Largs. The 901 and 906 buses run from Glasgow City center–Wemyss Bay
- Although it is only a short walk from the bus stop/train station to the park, we recommend that you get a taxi from the station as the site is located on a hill which is very steep and would be difficult to walk up with luggage.



6 HEATHER COURT



Get to know 6 Heather Court.

Our newest caravan situated close to an open play area, 6 Heather Court will sleep a maximum of 8 people, and is a 5-minute walk from the holiday park's reception and entertainment complex.

Get to know 5 Heather Court

5 Heather Court sleeps a maximum of 8 people and has an access ramp. Located near open green space, it is a 5-minute walk from the site's facilities and entertainment complex.

- Full kitchen facilities

78b KELLY MEADOWS



Get to know 78b Kelly Meadows.

78b Kelly Meadows is our caravan adapted for families with a wheelchair user(s) and those with mobility impairment. Sleeping a maximum of 6 people, 78b Kelly Meadows is located next to the entertainment complex, launderette, reception and shop.

What is included in a stay at 78b Kelly Meadows?

- Free entertainment passes
- Fresh bedding
- All crockery and kitchen utensils
- TV and DVD player
- Toys and books
- Accessible fully fitted kitchen.

What's inside?

- Two Twin Bedrooms
- Pullout sofa bed in the living room.
- Central Heating
- Double Glazed Windows
- Gas fire in the living room
- Accessible toilet facilities, adapted for a wheelchair users and those with mobility impairment.
- Lowered kitchen worktop
- A potable helper frame and toilet chair

25 MANOR PARK



Get to know 25 Manor Park

25 Manor Park is a spacious caravan located a few minutes away from the park's reception. It can sleep a maximum of 8.

- Fully fitted kitchen
- Balcony (accessed via steps)

Equipped with a disabled access ramp, 23 Skelmorlie View sleeps a maximum of 8 people. The caravan is right next to the park's entertainment complex. Fitted out with an access ramp and balcony.
